Dear Friend of the Foundation.

As a leader in the fight against epilepsy, the Epilepsy Foundation of Kentuckiana (EF Kentuckiana) invites you to celebrate with us and provide a sponsorship for the 2023 Kentucky Veterans of the Year Award Dinner on Wednesday, November 8 from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. at The Jeffersonian (10617 Taylorsville Road, Jeffersontown, Kentucky). This event is dedicated to celebrating the 295,000 Kentucky veterans who call Kentucky their home and who "Continue to Serve" their communities after taking off their uniform and defending this great country. Over 174,000 children, adults, and veterans with epilepsy and seizure disorders live throughout Kentucky and southern Indiana and the EF Kentuckiana is here to help. Sixty percent of combat injuries for veterans serving after 9/11 are from blast injuries and evidence-based research suggests that 40% of combat troops who suffer a traumatic brain injury (TBI) will develop post traumatic epilepsy (PTE). The likelihood of developing PTE is linked to the severity of the TBI. A penetrating TBI places the veteran at an increased risk of developing PTE due to severe bleeding in the brain and/or brain damage. A mild TBI is much harder to diagnose but the effects can still be severe and delayed up to 20+ years after the initial injury.

You likely know someone with or affected by epilepsy, but you may not know it. Here's a staggering statistic that surprises many people: 1 in 26 individuals will develop epilepsy in their lifetime. Many people don't like to talk about epilepsy even though epilepsy is the most common of the chronic serious brain diseases. More people are familiar with complications of horrible diseases like muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis, cerebral palsy, and Parkinson's disease, even though more people are affected by epilepsy than all those combined. Another surprising fact is that death can occur from epilepsy by prolonged seizures, sudden unexpected death in epilepsy (SUDEP), and other seizure-related causes such as drowning, falls, suffocation, and other accidents. In fact, SUDEP accounts for 34% of all sudden deaths in children. Let's not forget our veterans! Many heroes who served our country sustained a severe traumatic brain injury and their chances increase 53% of developing post-traumatic epilepsy and suffering lifelong challenges. The Kentucky Veterans of the Year Awards Dinner is a special event that we will host during Louisville Mayor Greenberg's "Week of Valor" leading up to Veterans Day.

This event will offer up to 150 veterans, family members, supporters from the medical and business community, community leaders, a night of scrumptious food, entertainment, and culminating with one male and one female veteran being recognized as the 2023 Kentucky Veteran of the Year. Additionally, the event will serve to raise awareness of epilepsy and the education, advocacy, outreach, and direct client services available through the EF Kentuckiana, that improve lives and help those living with epilepsy overcome the myriad of challenges and heartbreaking consequences resulting from potentially life-threatening seizures.
